



## COLLEGE BOARD ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSE LIST

Students must have AP send an official score report directly to UWRF to be awarded AP credit. We are instructed by AP not to accept student copies or high school copies as official documents. When students schedule the AP exam they should list UWRF as a school to receive the AP score report. Students who do not list UWRF as a score recipient when they take the AP must ask AP to send a supplemental score report to UWRF. A supplemental score request form is attached to the student copy of the score report. Students may also see <http://apcentral.collegeboard.com> (click on FAQs) for supplemental score request instructions. The AP college code for UWRF is 1918. Credit will be awarded only once for AP, International Baccalaureate (IB) or College Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams which are in the same subject.

History - European	3,4,5	3 credits for HIST 101 or 102. Student is permitted to take upper division European history courses (numbered "300" or higher) at UW-RF. If an upper division European history course is completed at UW-RF with a grade of "B" or better, an additional 3 credits may be awarded, crediting the student with both HIST 101 and 102.
History - United States	3,4,5	3 credits for HIST 100. If History major or minor, 3 credits for HIST 215 and student is permitted to take advanced U.S. history courses (numbered "300" or higher) at UW-RF. If an advanced U.S. history course is completed at UW-RF with a grade of "B" or better, an additional 3 credits may be awarded for HIST 216.
